**DIRECTIONS:** Taura Farms: from Springfield, take I-44 west to Exit 38. Go north on Hwy 97 approximately 3 miles to Lawrence 2110. East on 2110 approx 2 miles to Taura Farms on right. Outdoor grass arena or indoor with shredded rubber mix, use depending on weather.

**ENTRY PROCEDURES:** All entries must be made on the form provided. Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, with original signatures. Incomplete entries will be returned. NO entries will be taken over the phone. Entries close and must be received by closing date specified. *All entry fees and copies of current coggins tests must accompany the entry forms.* Checks may be made payable to Laura Alms. Trainers/coaches who wish to coach their students at the show must also sign the liability release below at the time the entry is submitted. **FEES:** The fee for all classes will be \$10.00 per class. An office fee of \$5.00 will be charged for each horse. If an entry is canceled prior to or on closing date, all fees will be refunded less a \$10.00 cancellation fee. If the entry is canceled after closing date, one-half of all fees will be refunded. All canceled entries must furnish a veterinarian or doctor's certificate to the Show Secretary to be eligible for a refund. At least 2 entries will be required to hold the prix caparilli classes. If those classes are cancelled, entry fees will be returned.

Ride times will be emailed. Anyone wishing their times to be sent by phone should include this information on their entry form

**CHECK IN:** Each exhibitor must report to the Show Secretary to pick up their show packets upon arrival at the show grounds. Show packets will only be issued if all fees are paid, entry forms are correctly filled out with all pertinent signatures, and the original current (with-in 12 months) COGGINS test for each horse submitted.

**GOVERNING RULES:** Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current USEF. Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith unless modifications are so listed. Classes not covered by such rules will be governed by Show Management.

**WEATHER:** In case of severe weather, please contact the Show Manager or Show Secretary for possible cancellation.

**DRESS:** Informal show attire will be enforced at the schooling shows. Riders may wear polo shirts or short sleeve blouses with collars or conservative sweaters (no tee shirts permitted), breeches, jodphurs, and English style riding boots must be worn. Helmets are required at all schooling shows. Anyone not conforming to the dress code will not be considered an entry in the class. Tack and equipment should follow USEF guidelines. Series Awards will consist of both shows held at Taura Farms: ( Date of 2<sup>nd</sup> show: Sept 11 2010)

Intro – Training: Minimum of 4 scores with 2 of them being the highest Test of the Level from both shows.

First and above: Minimum of 3 scores with 2 of them being the highest Test of the Level from both shows.

Minimum score to qualify:

Intro: 65 %

Training: 63 %

First and above: 60%

The Awards will be for Series Champion and Reserve Champion, there must be 3 Horse per Level per Show ( Intro – Training) for it to count. First Level and above no minimum horses per Level required, only average score requirement must be met.
